ABOUT THE TRUSTEE ROLE

Our Trustees play a pivotal role in ensuring the organisation is well governed, follows good practice relating to charities and meets our charitable objectives.

Each Trustee is expected to leverage their specific skills, knowledge, or experience to contribute to informed decision-making within the board.

The Key's Board of Trustees meets 6 times per calendar year combining in-person with remote meetings to benefit all members. Opportunities to join the Finance and Risk Sub Committee and other ad-hoc working groups may arise from time to time.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Always act in the best interests of The Key. You must not let your personal interests, views or prejudices affect your conduct as a trustee.
- Act reasonably and responsibly in all matters relating to The Key. You must act with as much care as if you were dealing with your own affairs, taking advice if you need it.
- Only use The Key's income and property for the purposes set out in its governing document.
- Make decisions in line with good practice and the rules set by The Key's governing document.
